To expedite processing, the following documents must accompany all application forms:

- ❖ Proof of high school graduation (copy of diploma) including English translation
- ❖ Copy of all high school and college transcripts including English translations
- ❖ *Proof of Immunization Compliance* form (including immunization records from your country – translated in English)
- ❖ Copy of passport that will be used to enter the U.S. (For students outside of the U.S.)
- ❖ Copy of current I-20, DS-2019, U.S. visa, permanent residency card, or U.S. passport (For students inside of the U.S.)
- ❖ Completed *Chronological Record of Education* form (For students applying for conditional admission)
- ❖ *Financial Guarantee* form and supporting bank statements (For students who require F-1/J-1 visas only)
